ERS has been appointed by BECTU to independently administer a consultative ballot on behalf of the Union.

This is a ballot to decide if BECTU will sign a formal agreement with the independent production employers association PACT covering the employment terms and conditions for all workers in UK independently produced TV drama.

Please note, that these terms were negotiated by branch representatives, and the union is strongly recommending that you vote to accept this agreement.
